*LifeNote is an annual charity event organized by local neurosurgeon Dr. Dan Friedlich to benefit the David Foster
Foundation https://davidfosterfoundation.com. It will be held at the Merc in Old Town Temecula. LifeNote is 2 days of musical performances from about 9am -7 pm and MTAC TV has reserved 1:00-4:00 pm on Saturday, Oct. 5th for our students. Depending on interest, teachers may be limited to the number of students they can enter but we will get estimates in the next few weeks from teachers on how many students they plan to enter will let you know. Teachers will register their students through our branch and pay the \$10 registration fee and then receive 1 admission ticket. If you are interested, I can also check on information about purchasing Additional tickets @\$10/each.

Musicales are recitals put on by the Temecula Valley division of MTAC (Music Teachers' Association of California). These are wonderful opportunities to enjoy music from other studios and sometimes other instruments as well.
